

NARRAGANSETT BAY WHEELMEN #2 Rev. 3/12
THE BARRINGTON RIDE (an original NBW ride)
 11 - 17 - 26 miles

START: Barrington High School, off Federal Ave.
 (Turn right at white church on Wampanoag Trail)

- 11 miles: Right on Warren. After Barrington, turn right on Middle Hwy.
- 17 miles: Right on Warren, rejoin long route at Barneyville, then follow solid outline.
- 26 miles: follow solid outline.

SCENIC NOTES:

This ride crosses the Barrington River and heads north into Seekonk along the Palmer River. Returning south to Barrington you will pass Barrington Beach, the RI Country Club, Nayant Point, Echo Lake, Haines State Park, and Bullocks Cove. Now that the East Bay Bike Path crosses our route, you can join it at various places - in Barrington itself, to cross the river, and later at Narragansett and Rt. 103.
