

NARRAGANSETT BAY WHEELMEN MAP #8

THE BRISTOL - PORTSMOUTH RIDE

8 - 11 & 22 mile rides
an optional loop adds 3 miles to each loop

START: Newport Creamery, Rt. 114, Bristol, RI

8 or 11 miles: left from Rt. 114 onto High St.

11 or 15 miles: at Mt. Hope Bridge, turn around, turn right on High St.

22 or 25 miles: cross Mt. Hope Bridge for the Portsmouth loop.

SCENIC NOTES

Another original NBW ride!!! Views of Narragansett Bay, Mt. Hope Bay, the Bristol Peninsula, Colt State Park (owned by Samuel P. Colt, nephew of the COLT REVOLVER inventor), and Coggeshall Farm Museum are highlights not to be missed. Take a trip through Blithewold or Roger Williams College campus. Over the bridge, ride the Sakonnet River path and the Sakonnet Bridge. On the way back, Bristol Harbor offers rides to Prudence Island in the middle of the bay. Also, note the homes on High St. formerly owned by sea-captains, also the 19th century schools and churches.
