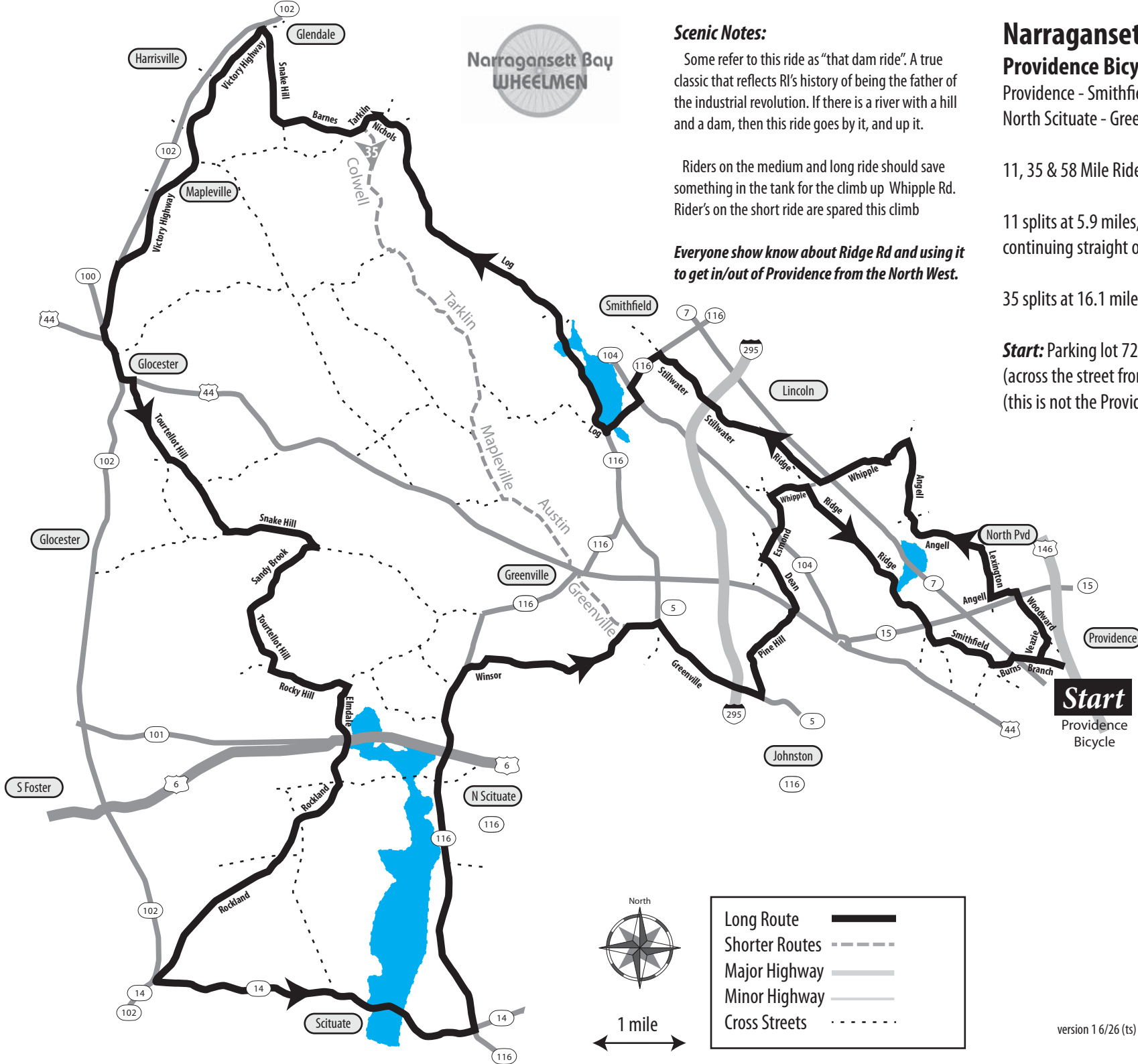
Providence - Smithfield - Glocester
