EASTERN CONNECTICUT TOUR

HOPE VALLEY - HOPKINTON - VOLUNTOWN

11 - 30 & 35 miles rides (extended to 50 in '02 - no map for extension)

START: Victory Cycles, Rt. 138, Hope Valley, RI

11 miles: right onto Canonchet Rd. from Rt. 3

30 miles: right onto Rt. 49 after Clarks Falls

35 miles: straight at Rt. 49 intersection

SCENIC NOTES

This adventurous ride goes through a largely wooded yet very rural area with stretches along CT. farmlands. Hopkinton & Clark Falls are old picturesque NE villages. Note the mill pond and waterfall just on the outskirts of Clarks Falls. Voluntown is also an old mill town now noted as the location of the Viet Nameras' Committee for Nonviolent Action. On Wassup Rd. you may climb the fire tower for a view of the distant ocean & the farm lands. Canonchet is a classic mill village notable for the town green & pond. Food stop is at Pat's Place, in Voluntown.
