WESTERLY-WATCH HILL

20 - 40 - 64 mile rides

START: URI, lot at end of W Independence Way

20 miles: Left on Shannock Rd in Shannock

40 miles: Left on Rt 216 from Diamond Hill Rd

64 miles: Right on Rt 216 from Diamond Hill Rd

HELMETS ARE REQUIRED

SCENIC NOTES: Ride on rural roads through scenic areas of South County. Short ride goes through Carolina, Shannock and Kenyon, home of the Jonnycake mill. The 40-miler goes through Woodville and Ashaway, joining the long ride back through Wood River Junction and by Worden Pond. The long ride goes to the coastal areas of Misquamicut Beach, along the Pawcatuck River (the boundary between RI and CT), Winnepaug Salt Pond, and into Victorian Westerly - home of the first carousel, built in 1870. The Watch Hill Coast Guard Station offers a fantastic view.
