

NARRAGANSETT BAY WHEELMEN #44 Rev. 4/06
SOUTH COUNTY COAST CRUISE
 19 - 34 - 42 miles

START: Univ of Rhode Island. Parking lot at end of W Independence Way (enter between Hall of Fame and brick building on Rt. 138)

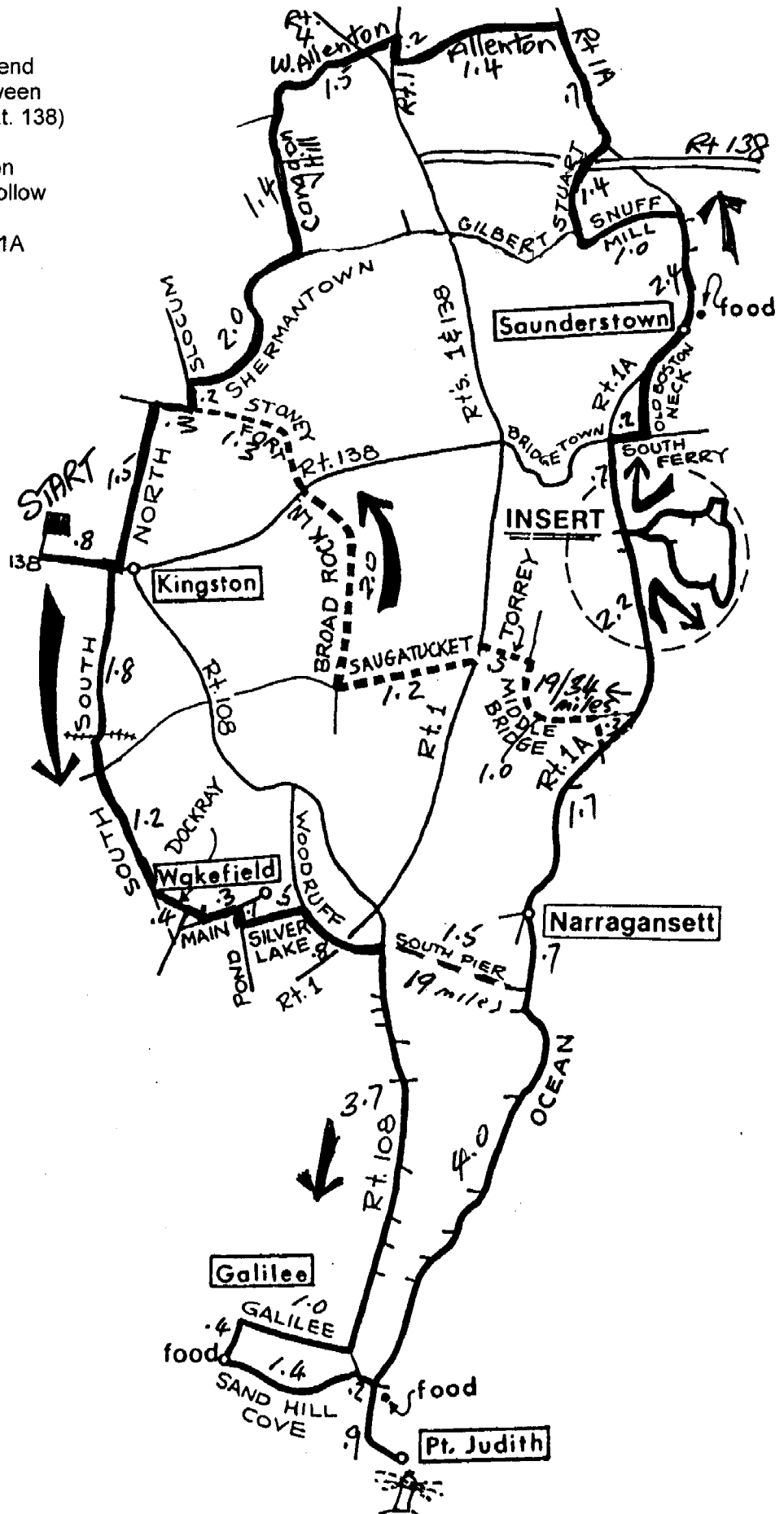
19 miles: Straight on South Pier at intersection with Rt 108, then Left on Rt 1A and follow 30 miler (dotted line) back to start.

34 miles: Left onto Old Boston Neck from Rt 1A then follow dotted line.

42 miles: follow solid line

SCENIC NOTES:

From URI's Kingston campus the ride heads south to Wakefield and its historic sites. The longer rides continue south to the fishing village of Galilee and Point Judith lighthouse before turning north by the Narragansett beaches and up to Bonnet Shores. Long ride passes close by Gilbert Stuart's birthplace. Food stops marked on the map.
