SCITUATE RIDE - PHASE III

SCITUATE - FOSTER - COVENTRY
15 - 25 & 30 mile rides

START: Scituate Jr./Sr. High School, Trimtown & Rockland Rds. Leave school by side entrance on Trimtown Rd.

- 15 miles: right onto Foster Center Rd. from Plainfield Pike
- 25 miles: left to Old Plainfield Pike at jct of Rts. 14 & 102
- 30 miles: straight onto Victory Highway from Plainfield

SCENIC NOTES

This is a very scenic and serene ride that was originated by clubmember Mike Destefano in 1989. There are several waterfalls, dams and reservoir crossings along the way. The short ride heads out to Foster Center Rd. then returns along Central Pike. Both the intermediate & long rides cross the Scituate Reservoir which, if water level is low enough, will allow you to see the remains of the old village millworks from 17th & 18th century New England. In total, the long & short rides cross these areas four times during the ride.
