SWANSEA - DIGHTON ROCK RIDE

Swansea - Somerset - Berkley - Dighton - Rehoboth
 15 - 30 - 50 mile rides

START: McDonald's Rt6, Swansea, MA
 Ride exits parking lot from the back.

15 miles: Left on Main St. at bottom of hill
 30 miles: Left on Elm St.
 50 miles: Right on Elm St.

SCENIC NOTES:

Starting in Swansea, the ride travels into Somerset along the Taunton River. In Berkley head to Dighton Rock State Park. The rock itself is an 11-foot high "glacial erratic" boulder, covered with petroglyphs of ancient and uncertain origin (explanations range from Portuguese explorers, to Vikings, to Native Americans). The rock once rested on the shore of the Taunton River but is now enclosed in a museum (open to late September). Thanks to Bob Paiva for the 50 mile extension.
