## THE TWO ROCKS RIDE

TAUNTON - BERKELEY - ASSONET & NORTH DIGHTON

13 & 24 mile rides

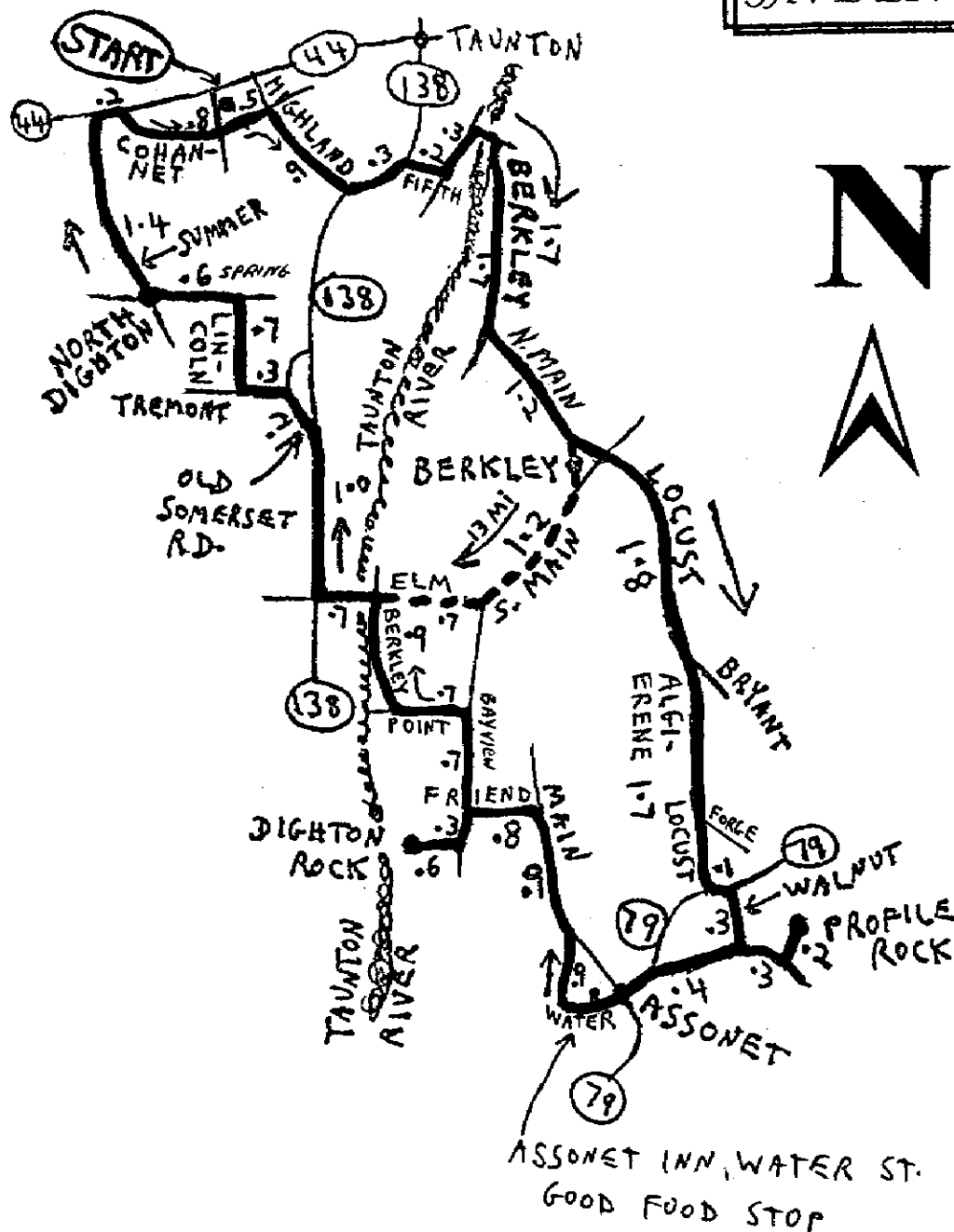
**START:** Shaw's Plaza,  
Rt. 44 & Warner Blvd. Taunton, MA

13 miles: bear right onto Berkeley Town Green, right to S. Main.

24 miles: follow outline of map, doing both "rock" loops

### SCENIC NOTES

A great original NBW ride - short and spectacular. It includes two unusual sights. Dighton Rock: with its unusual & mysterious inscriptions as well as Profile Rock: an interesting striking resemblance of an Indian in headdress. A visit to the Assonet Inn & Millpond are highlights of this trip. There are several food stops on route including the country store in Berkeley & the Assonet Inn. There are the usual fast food locales near the end of the ride. CAUTION: there is a dirt road about 3/10<sup>th</sup> mile on Pond St. in Berkeley. The ride also meanders along the Taunton River, offering some fantastic views.
