Buttonwoods – Oakland Beach – Rocky Point

15 & 24 mile rides

(THIS RIDE IS AN ORIGINAL WARWICK BIKE CLUB ROUTE & NBW RIDE)

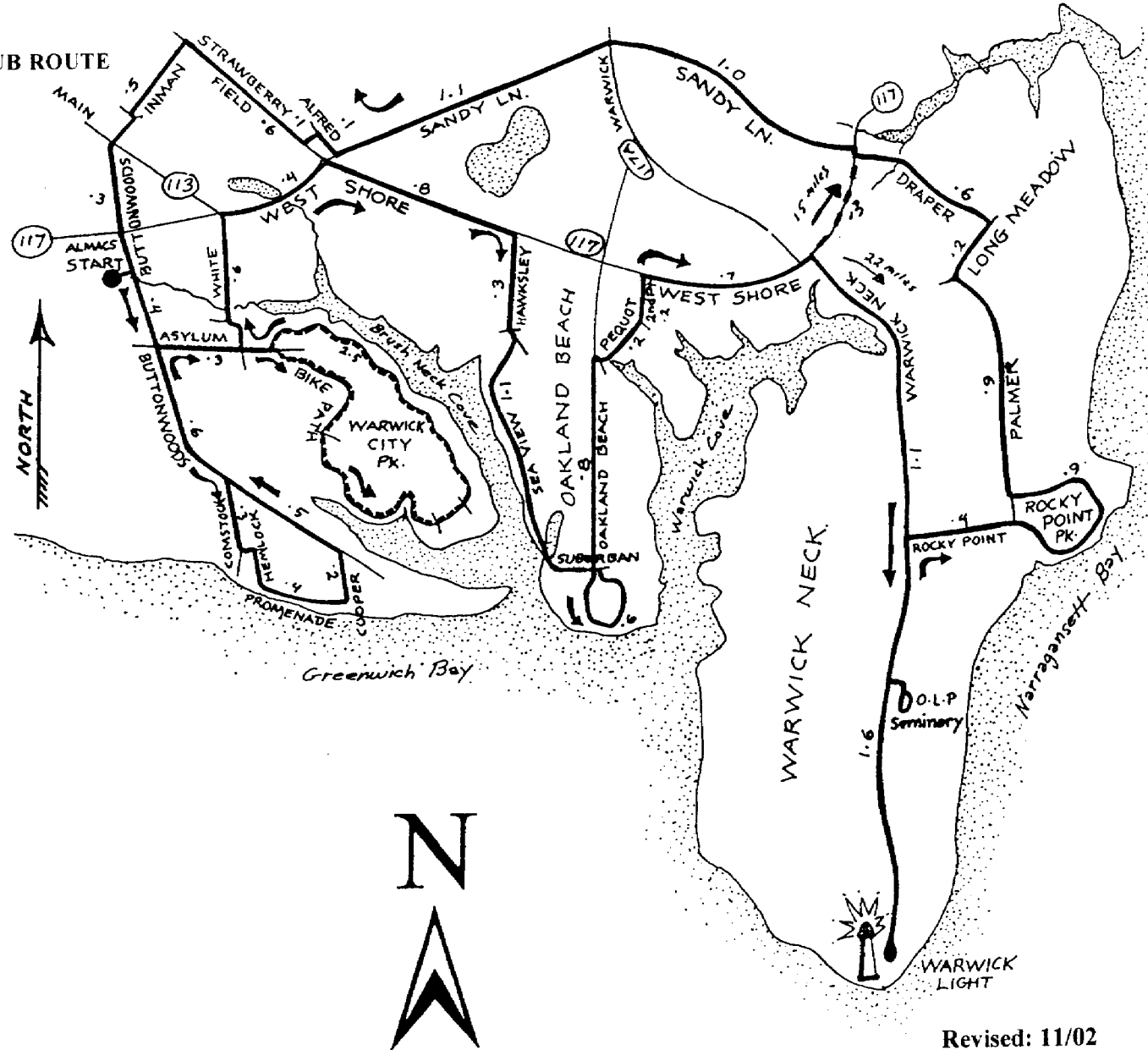
START: Buttonwoods Plaza – rt. 117: Warwick, RI

15 miles: continue on west Shore Rd at Warwick Neck, turn left onto sandy Lane

24 miles: right onto Warwick Neck from west Shore Rd.

SCENIC NOTES

Enjoy an old NBW ride (originated in the 1920s by the Warwick Bicycle Club) The ride may be lengthened by a loop through Warwick City Park, if it is opened. Next, are the summer homes & mansions along Oakland Beach (the area has been restored with Federal funding) with a fantastic view of Greenwich Bay. Tour Warwick Neck past O.L.P. Seminary & past the former Rocky Point Park for views of Narragansett Bay. Beware of airplanes!!
