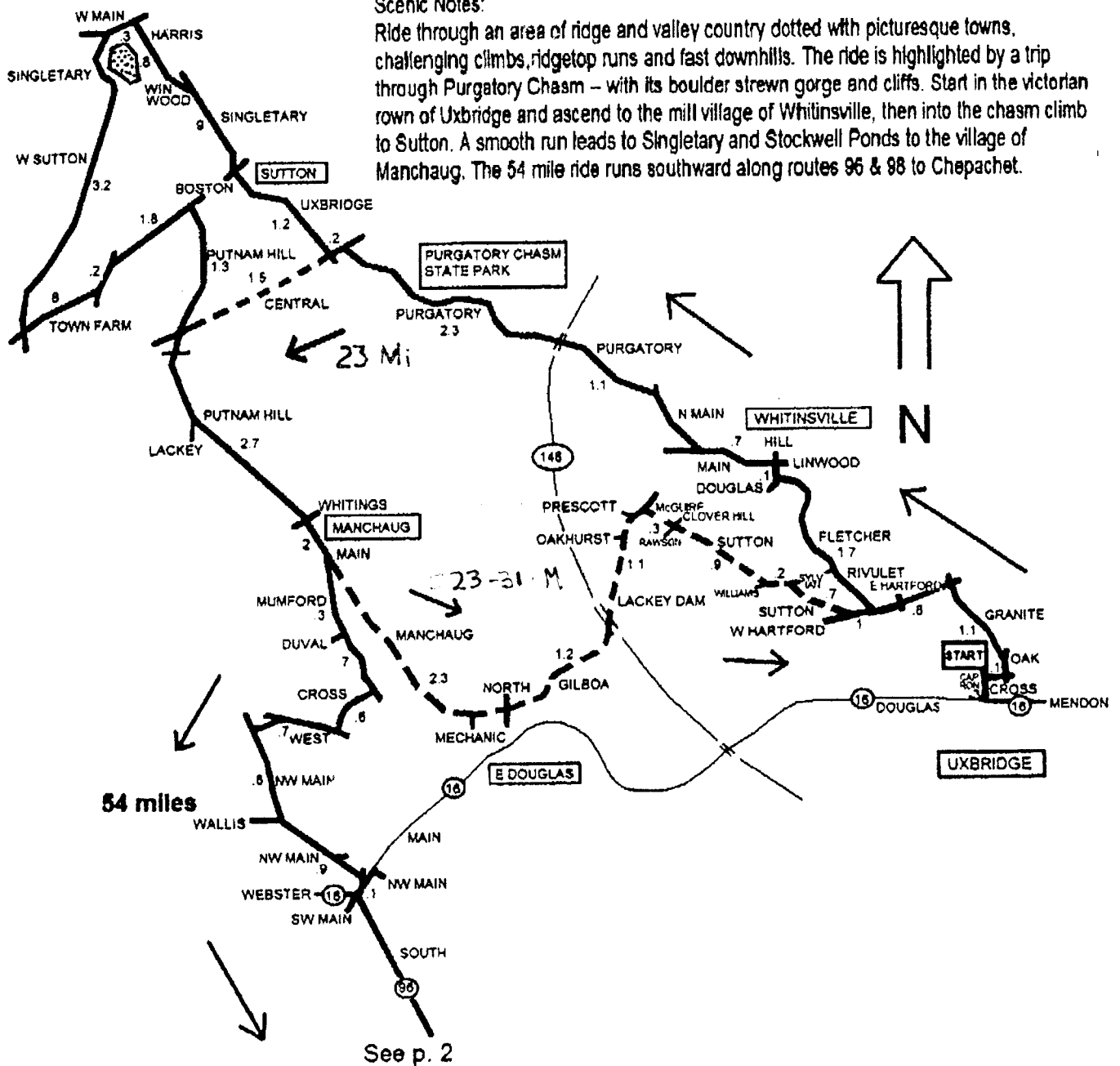

HELMETS REQUIRED

Miles:
 23- Straight on Central at 1st split, straight on Main at 2nd split
 31 - Right into Uxbridge at 1st split, straight on Main at 2nd split
 54- Right into Uxbridge at 1st split, right on Mumford at 2nd split

Scenic Notes:

Ride through an area of ridge and valley country dotted with picturesque towns, challenging climbs, ridgetop runs and fast downhill. The ride is highlighted by a trip through Purgatory Chasm - with its boulder strewn gorge and cliffs. Start in the victorian town of Uxbridge and ascend to the mill village of Whitinsville, then into the chasm climb to Sutton. A smooth run leads to Singletary and Stockwell Ponds to the village of Manchaug. The 54 mile ride runs southward along routes 96 & 88 to Chepachet.
