

START: W Gloucester Elementary School, Rt. 94

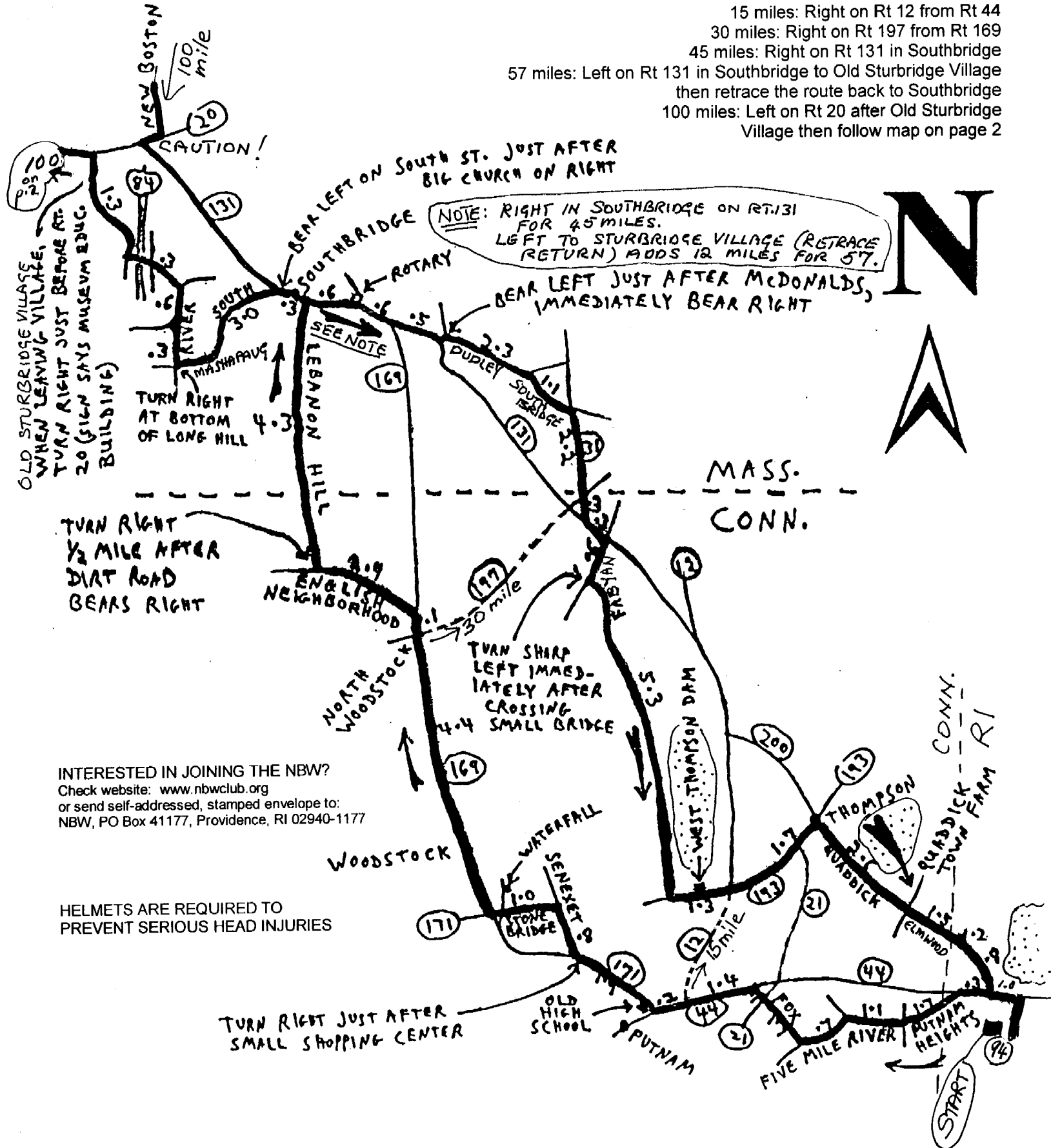
15 miles: Right on Rt 12 from Rt 44

30 miles: Right on Rt 197 from Rt 169

45 miles: Right on Rt 131 in Southbridge

57 miles: Left on Rt 131 in Southbridge to Old Sturbridge Village then retrace the route back to Southbridge

100 miles: Left on Rt 20 after Old Sturbridge Village then follow map on page 2



NOTE: RIGHT IN SOUTHBRIDGE ON RT.131 FOR 45 MILES. LEFT TO STURBRIDGE VILLAGE (RETRACE RETURN) ADDS 12 MILES FOR 57.

BEAR LEFT ON SOUTH ST. JUST AFTER BIG CHURCH ON RIGHT

BEAR LEFT JUST AFTER McDONALDS, IMMEDIATELY BEAR RIGHT

TURN SHARP LEFT IMMEDIATELY AFTER CROSSING SMALL BRIDGE

TURN RIGHT 1/2 MILE AFTER DIRT ROAD BEARS RIGHT

TURN RIGHT AT BOTTOM OF LONG HILL

OLD STURBRIDGE VILLAGE WHEN LEAVING VILLAGE, TURN RIGHT JUST BEFORE RT. 20 (SIGN SAYS MUSEUM EDUC. BUILDING)

SCENIC NOTES:

Rolling ride on RI, CT and MA country roads. 57 and 100 milers pass Old Sturbridge Village, a reconstruction of mid 1800's village and farm life. Century riders head north on a beautiful, if hilly, loop, with sweeping views from the ridge road after Warren. Be sure to carry food and water on this loop as there aren't many food stops once you leave Sturbridge. Take care on busy Rts 20 and 131. Return on quiet roads by the West Thompson Dam and Thompson village.
