15 mile ride

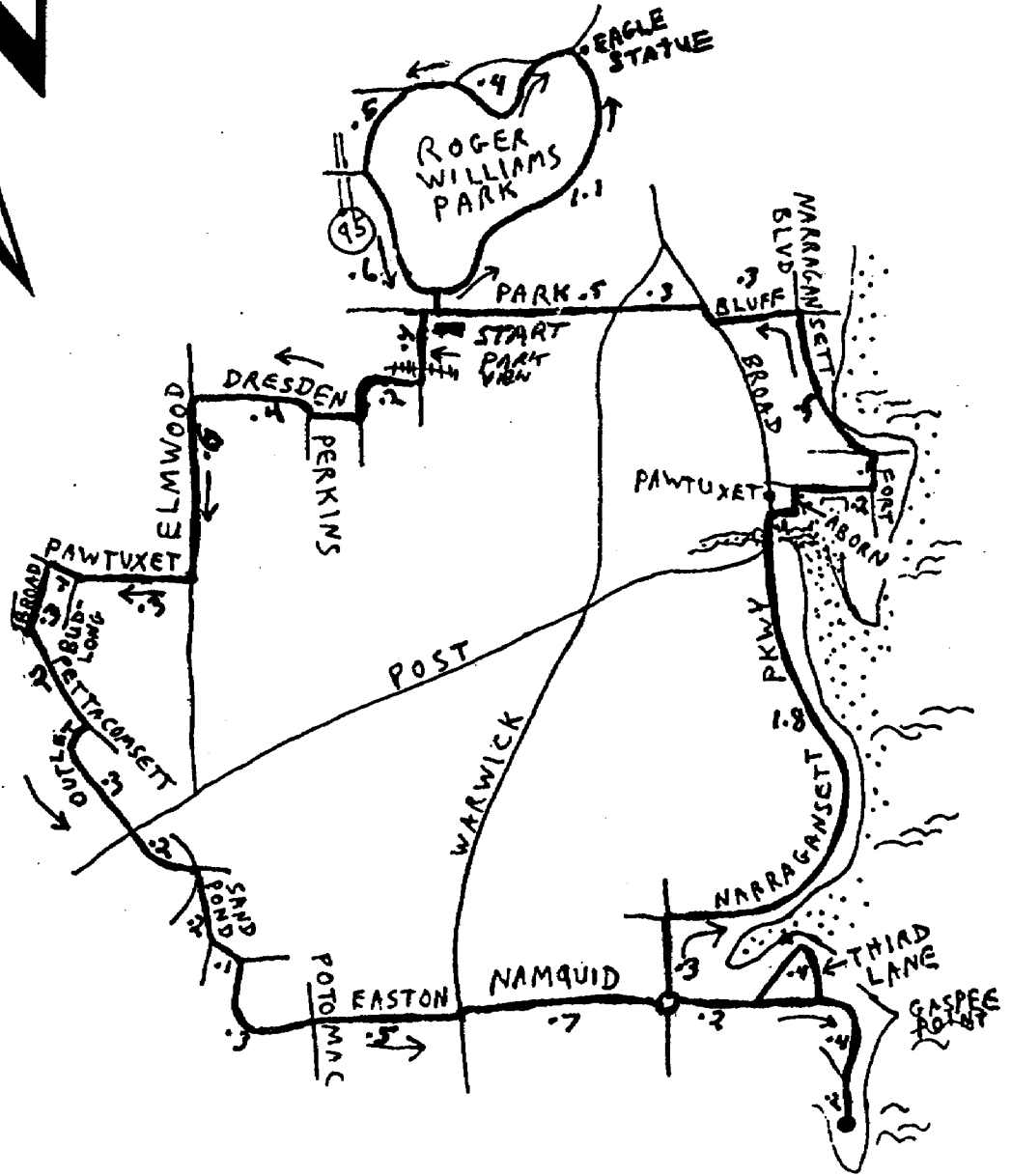
START: Park View Middle School, Park Ave., Cranston, RI

A unique winter ride which is close to home, yet scenic. The Start takes you from Cranston into Warwick. An extension takes you down to Gaspee Point. Heading back towards Cranston, a spin along Narragansett Bay offers spectacular winter scenic views of the bay. Finish the ride with a trek through Roger Williams Park. Enjoy the botanical gardens, the zoo and Museum of Science & Natural History. when you have some extra time. The park has been renovated & upgraded in recent years. The zoo hosts two polar bears and various major attractions during the year.
