BRIMFIELD ANTIQUE RIDE 34 MILES

(BRIMFIELD--HOLLAND--UNION, CN.--WALES)

START: BRIMFIELD, MA. or UNION, CN.

SCENIC NOTES

Starting from Union, this ride circuits four towns, passing an area of rugged, wooded hills separated by ponds and lakes. From Union green, twitted country lanes will descend to the Staffordville Reservoir. Wales is a village on the Lake George shore and host a country fair in August. Heading to Brimfield brings you over high ridges with farms and views ending downhill to Brimfield. Note its green, white church and Victorian own hall. Explore the antique shops and merchants set up for the July flea market. From Brimfield, head south to the summer cottage village of Holland, along the Hamilton Reservoir shores back to Union.

DIRECTIONS TO START OF RIDE

Rt. 44 W. from Greenville for approx. 20 miles to Rt. 169 N in Pomfret, Ct. Follow Rt. 169 N. for approx. 9 miles to Rt. 197 E. in N. Woodstock. Follow Rt. 169 E. for 11 miles to Union, Ct. just past Rt. 171. Park at the white church on right at the green in the center of Union, Ct.
