

NARRAGANSETT BAY WHEELMEN #38 (Adapted for Dec 21 2014 ride)

JAMESTOWN RIDE

18 – 25 – 30 miles

START: Beavertail Lighthouse State Park, Jamestown, RI

- 18 miles: Left on Carr, then left on North Main
- 25 miles: Right on North Main from Rt 138 Service Rd
- 30 miles: Left on North Main from Rt 138 Service Rd

SCENIC NOTES:

This ride is a shortened version of our old Rhody Roundup route. Scenic points on this ride include Beavertail lighthouse and Fort Wetherill. Great views of Narragansett Bay from all aspects as you circle the island. Jamestown Museum (19th century schoolhouse and old-time ferry memorabilia) and Fire Dept Memorial Building with antique fire-fighting apparatus.

CAUTION:

Island roads can be sandy.
There's a very short (a few yards) unpaved section by the marina on Raquet.
