Slatersville - Uxbridge - Millville - Blackstone

12 - 29 Miles

START: Slatersville Plaza, Jct Rts. 5, 102 & 146A, Slatersville,
(No. Smithfield, RI)

12 Miles: Right on Central St. in Millville

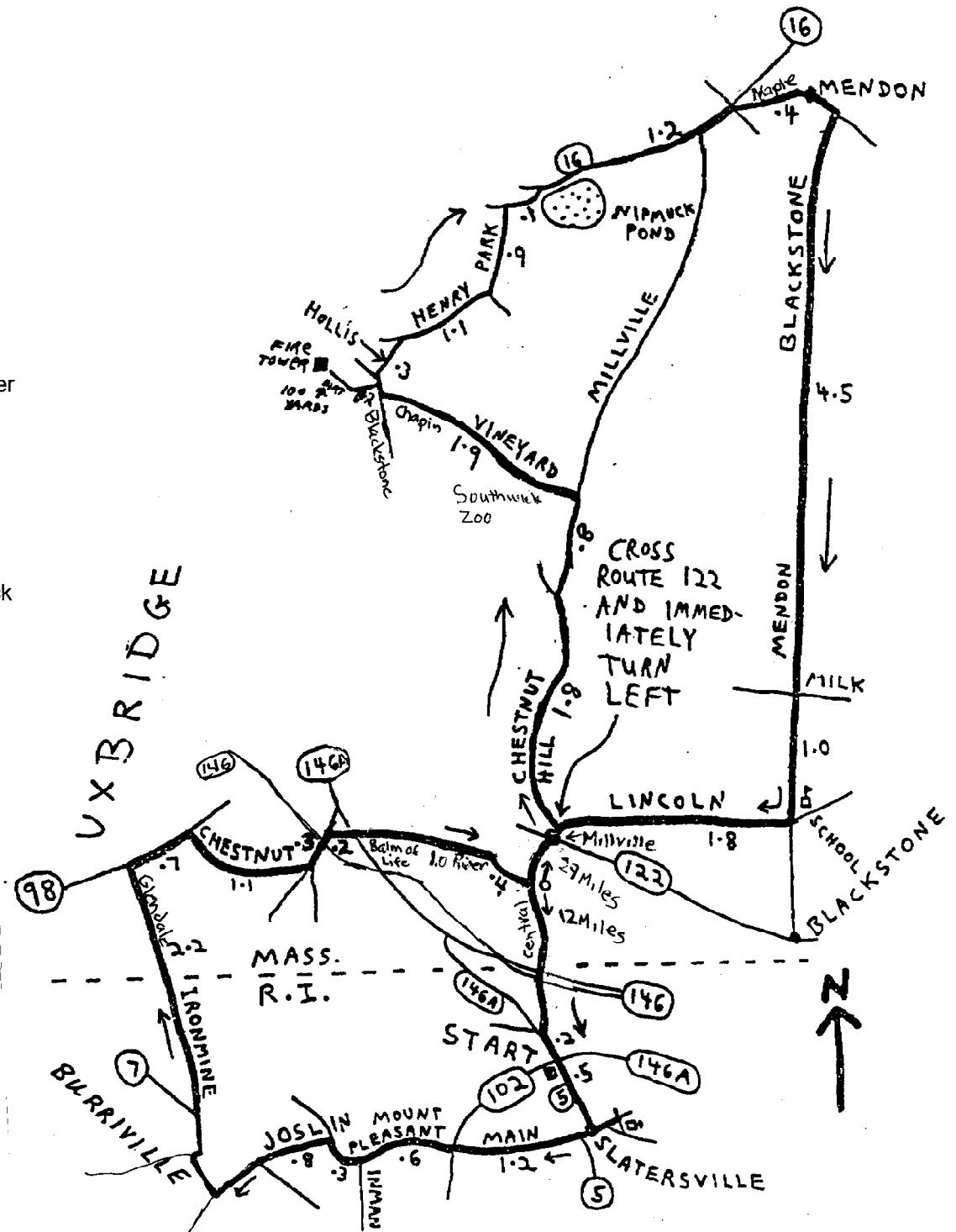
29 Miles: Left on Central St. in Millville

SCENIC NOTES:

This ride originated from Ride #43 in Howard Stone's book "Short Bike Rides in Rhode Island". Narrow wooded lanes meander through small towns (note Slatersville's triangular "green" and traditional white church and Town Hall). Old mills line the Branch River (note the two tier dam a mile outside town) The long ride crossed the MA border, coasting downhill to the Blackstone River into Millville. Just outside Millville is the 1769 Chestnut Hill Meeting House.

Sightseeing Stops: Southwick's Zoo on Vineyard St., or the fire tower just after Vineyard St. for a view of Boston. Spin by Nipmuck Pond into Mendon.

Straight Roads back to the start.
