HELMETS ARE REQUIRED ON NBW RIDES

- 19 miles: Right at end of Bow St onto Rhodes
- 30 miles: Right on Taunton St from George
- 44 miles: Left on Taunton St from George

**SCENIC NOTES:**

Start at Diamond Hill Park (formerly a ski area), with its veined 200 ft quartz cliff. The ride passes Sneech Pond, farmlands, scenic views and the village of Sheldonville. The two longer rides enjoy a swooping downhill run on High St in Plainville. The longest ride turns north through Wrentham, crossing its historic common, and heading into Norfolk, before turning south through Foxboro's Gilbert Hill State Forest. All rides return by crossing the Diamond Hill Reservoir. In season, enjoy the ice cream at the end of the ride (across from Diamond Hill Park).
